Enrichment Descriptions

Art – Let your child's inner artist shine through learning how to paint, draw and create beautiful works of art. Lessons will give your child the tools to create incredible depictions of the world around them, while increasing their fine motor skills and instilling confidence, independence, and a joy for discovery and exploration! Students will leave each session with a new eye for the beauty that surrounds them, and with a series of unique pieces of art for their room or for gifts for their loved ones!

Bollywood – *Andaaz* will be teaching your kids belly-dancing, Indian folk, "modern", jazz funk, and hip-hop.

Camp – Register for as many days as you like. Camp will include outdoor games with Coach George, art, chess, and brain teaser games.

Chess – **After School Chess** Fun, dynamic, Interactive lessons bring chess to life. Prizes & Tournaments! Compete for medals and glory. Earn prizes for practice and sportsmanship. All Ages & Skill Levels! Classes divided by age and skill level. New lessons every session! Chess helps kids do better in school by exercising and improving focus, memory, patience, pattern recognition, creativity, and critical thinking

Crochet – Crochet is a fiber craft that uses a hook and yarn. With just these simple tools it enhances many life skills: hand-eye coordination; creative problem solving; research and planning; and even socialization and communication skills. All of this while also providing a fun time that engages the mind! Research shows that engaging in repetitive tasks helps focus the mind, so regular projects become a fun way to help study!

Drama Theatre- Throughout the sessions, students will learn skills to develop confidence and creativity by engaging in performing arts activities. Students will work together to act, design, and organize a short performance for friends and family by the end of the session. By participating, students will gain problem solving techniques, confidence with public speaking, and a willingness to take initiative.

Flag Pulling Games- Coach George - The games of Capture the flag, 300, Flag Football and Infection will help increase hand eye coordination, balance, teamwork skills, strategic planning, and confidence

For the Love of Music - Foster a love of music! This class will focus on many aspects of music: great music listening (Bach to Rock), as well as activities to explore music history and music theory (how music works). Students will also have an opportunity to gain hands-on experience on different instruments which includes guitar as well as ukulele.

Homework Club and Public Speaking - Are you tired of fighting with your kids about homework? Homework and Public Speaking Club is designed to provide a place for students to work on their homework, reading and other projects, as well as build confidence and basic skills in public speaking in a structured and supportive setting.

Hip-Hop/Stomp Dance –Dance promotes creativity, improves self-esteem, encourages socialization and an active lifestyle and...it is simply...FUN!

Intro to Improv & Performance – Improvisation is the foundation of all theatre. Our teachers have years of experience both performing and teaching team-building, cooperation, discovery, and trust through improvisation. Students will be introduced to improvisation as an art form and will develop the skills necessary to use improvisation in live performance scenarios.

Life Science and STEM - What makes something alive? What does it need to survive? How is it related to other living things? For students in Grades 1-2 we'll explore all these questions and more in "All About Organisms." Is DNA your destiny? In our "Introduction to Genetics" course for students in Grades 3-5 we'll explore the world of DNA and introduce topics in gene-environment interactions. In addition, the club will take part in experiments that will have students learning, smiling, and looking forward to coming each week.

Life Skills - Life Skills provides an opportunity for kids to learn and practice activities of skills that we utilize day to day. Activities include (but are not limited to), learning to: read a recipe, measure ingredients, gift wrap presents, write thank you notes/invitations, sort and fold laundry, pack lunches, sign their name in cursive, use simple tools, communicate more effectively, work in teams, change batteries, make knots, tie shoes, manage money, change a diaper, and more. Some tasks, such as money management and communication skills, will be a part of each weekly session.

Multi-Sports- Coach George - Would you like to play the sports you love and didn't know you loved? You can try out several different sports throughout the session. Sports will include Basketball, Football, Soccer, Street Hockey, Dodge Ball & Ultimate Polo to name a few.

Robotics/Engineering – Activities range from speed circuits, building piper computers, codable robots and more. Activities are based on grade.

Russian Language - Level 1 students will learn phonics, introductory vocabulary, and basic every day phrases. Level 2 students will further develop their fluency.

Soccer- Coach George - FKA Soccer is geared towards new & experienced student athletes. They will learn the rules, fundamentals and techniques to be a successful soccer player, in addition to learning how to be a good team player and teammate.

Spanish – The kids will learn how to read, write, talk, play games and sing in Spanish.

Strategic Thinking- Students will have an opportunity to work on homework assignments and get assistance from a CA certified K-6 teacher. Students will also have the option of playing strategy-based board games such as Checkers, Chinese Checkers, GoBang, Othello and others.

Story Telling Through the Lens- PICTURE PERFECT---POINT, CLICK AND SHOOT. An introduction to digital photography and cinematography. Learn the aesthetics of visual arts by telling a story through images. We will have hands-on experience with digital cameras as each student creates a visual composition of non-narrative work. Students will learn to tell a story by learning composition, lighting, color, and tone. Digital cameras will be provided.

Tae Kwon Do/Kickboxing - An introductory experience to the world of martial arts, in which students will learn the basics of the Korean martial art of Tae Kwon Do. Students will learn and develop various techniques revolving around blocking, punching, kicking and self-defense techniques. Participants will also enhance their strength, flexibility, conditioning and even learn to break boards!

Yoga - Encourage your child's inner light to shine! Come join us as we stretch, play games and relax to unite our bodies and minds! Yoga improves physical wellness, behavior and mental health. Parents are welcome to enroll.
