What is the FFA?

The Miramar Ranch Family-Faculty Organization (“FFA”) is a parent-led nonprofit organization, dedicated to enhancing the educational experience at Miramar Ranch through volunteer work and fundraising.

Our teachers, staff, and all parents or guardians of Miramar Ranch students are automatically members of the FFA.

What does the FFA do?

We raise money and foster community by hosting different school and family events; we volunteer inside and outside the classroom; and we support our teachers by paying for educational programs, supplies, and additional staff support.
